Course Overview: The purpose of this course is to educate occupational and physical therapists to Vestibular rehabilitation for aging adults. Specifics will address major vestibular physiological and functional reasons, examination and treatment management strategies for people in skilled nursing facility.

Course Objectives: At the end of this course Students will be able to:

- 1. Perform a comprehensive vestibular examination of aging adults with consideration for history, current and past, red and yellow flags, safety, vision, sensory, balance and function.
- 2. Identify and differentiate between peripheral vs. central vestibular function.
- **3.** Create a plan of care and goals to progress patients vestibular functioning with a rationale to support progression.
